

Job Title:	Mechanical Assembler – Level 2

## Job purpose

This mid-level position provides the opportunity to build ultra-high precision, cutting edge machinery, in a booming, rapidly evolving field.

## Duties and Responsibilities

As a Mechanical Assembler Level 2 you would be involved in every step of the machine building process of Titan’s 3D printers. The day-to-day tasks can vary greatly. Flexibility and the ability to stay focused in a fast paced, ever changing environment is critical. A few examples of tasks that would be assigned to this position are as follows:

- Machine assembly.
- Component prep and fabrication.
- Alignment of linear components using high precision laser tooling.
- QC and inventory of incoming components from in house and third-party suppliers.
- Repair of existing, on site machines.
- Rigging, Lifting, and moving of delicate equipment.
- Maintenance of shop equipment and or facilities as needed.

## Qualifications

To effectively fill the role of Mechanical Assembler Level 2, the ideal candidate would meet the following qualifications:

- Highschool diploma, GED, or equivalent.
- Proficiency in fractional math.
- Strong skills in reading and interpreting part and assembly drawings.
- Strong skills with hand tools and power tools.
- Prior professional mechanical experience, 2 years.
- Experience with precision tools, dial indicators, calipers, ect.
- Valid Colorado driver license / clean driving record.
- Understanding of safe working practices
- Forklift Certification Class I-V (preferred but not required)

## Working conditions

This is a full-time position requiring 40 hours per week Monday through Friday. Some over time, weekends and evening work may be required in special and rare circumstances. The work environment will be in a warehouse/shop environment and may require some work outdoors from time to time.

## Physical requirements

This position requires lifting objects up to 75 pounds on a regular basis, standing and or sitting for extended periods of time. You may be required to work in confined spaces, from heights and in an environment with moderate to loud noise levels. This position will require use of Personal Protective Equipment, including wearing a respirator in some instances, gloves, eye protection, hard hats, protective footwear, etc.
