

Job Title:	Welder – Level 1
Reports To:	Welding Lead
Dept:	Production

Job purpose

This entry-level position provides the opportunity to develop high quality welding and fabrication skills under the mentorship of Titan’s lead welder. Titan seeks a motivated individual that is seeking precision welding and fabrication skills to produce precision equipment.

Duties and Responsibilities

As a Welder Level 1 you would work under the guidance of the Weld Shop lead to assist in fabrication of precision structures.

Examples of tasks and responsibilities include:

- Material Handling
- Reading drawings to interpret cut lengths and tolerances
- Bandsaw operations
- Basic welding tasks (mostly Steel MIG)
- Torch operations
- Grinding operations
- Fixturing

Qualifications

To effectively fill the role of Welder Level 1, the ideal candidate would meet the following qualifications:

- Highschool diploma, GED, or equivalent.
- Prior professional welding experience a plus.
- Welding certifications are a plus.
- Proficiency in fractional math.
- Strong skills in reading and interpreting blueprints and assembly drawings.
- Strong skills with industry tools.
- Experience with precision tools, dial indicators, calipers, ect.
- Valid Colorado driver license / clean driving record.
- Understanding of safe working practices
- Forklift Certification Class I-V (preferred but not required)

Working conditions

This is a full-time position requiring 40 hours per week Monday through Friday. Some over time, weekends and evening work may be required in special and rare circumstances. The work environment will be in a warehouse/shop environment and may require some work outdoors from time to time.

Physical requirements

This position requires lifting objects up to 75 pounds on a regular basis, standing and or sitting for extended periods of time. You may be required to work in confined spaces, from heights and in an environment with moderate to loud noise levels. This position will require use of Personal Protective Equipment, including wearing a mask, wearing a respirator in some instances, gloves, eye protection, hard hats, protective footwear, etc.
